
IN MANDAMUS

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration of respondent's motion to name relator a vexatious litigator, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted and Carl E. Whitacre is found to be a vexatious litigator under S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B). Accordingly, it is ordered that Carl E. Whitacre is prohibited from continuing or instituting legal proceedings in this court without first obtaining leave. Any request for leave shall be submitted to the clerk of this court by delivery service, by mail addressed to the Clerk of the Supreme Court, or in person for the court's review.

It is further ordered that respondent's motion to dismiss is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
